



## Rough Map




### Busan National University Hospital

Tosung Station





without health insurance!*


- Medical cost assistance for migrants -



Need to see a doctor? Don't have health insurance because you don't have an alien registration card?

Now you can get medical bill subsidies from the Medical Care Assistance Program for Foreign Workers and the Underprivileged!

Visit one of the designated hospitals and have your medical costs covered by the program. Medical bill subsidies are also available for hospitalization and surgery.



## What is the Medical Care Assistance Program for Migrant Workers and the Underprivileged?

The program covers medical costs for those who are not entitled to the National Health Insurance because of the sojourn status. In other words, you can enjoy the same health benefits as Korean nationals with health insurance.

\* The program is funded by the Ministry of Health & Welfare and Busan Metropolitan City.

### Beneficiaries:

Foreign patients who don't qualify for health insurance and have stayed longer than 90 days in South Korea must meet one of the following conditions

- ① Migrant workers who were either previously employed or currently employed by Korea-based companies
- ② Female marriage immigrants who have not yet gained Korean citizenship
- ③ Those recognized as refugee, applying for refugee status, or granted sojourn status for humanitarian reasons
- ④ Children under the age of 18 of those who meet the above conditions



## Coverage

• Up to ₩ 10 million provided for the following medical services:

● Hospitalization, surgery, or a maximum of four other related outpatient visits (including one pre-hospitalization/surgery consultation and three post related visits)

● renal tests (allowance of medical care and ultrasonography)

\* Outpatient treatment for children under the age of 18 of those who meet conditions from Beneficiaries ① to ④ is covered

\* However, uninsured benefits and care by physician of choice are not covered.

• The number of benefits given is not limited.
